1. The applicants will supply the following:
 - a. A fully completed application form
 - b. Registration fee of £8 (made payable by cheque to **Trinity Arts and Craft Guild**)
 - c. A recorded CD by the two applicants which should include two songs (one of them by Schubert)
2. The entries should be sent to: **Chelsea Schubert Festival, Holy Trinity Sloane Square, Sloane Street, London, SW1Z 9BZ.** (deadline for entries is **15 August 2010**)
3. The successful duo will be notified by late August and invited to perform in the first round on the afternoon of September 15th 2010 at St. Saviours Church, Walton Street, in front of a judging panel. The duo will be asked to perform two songs (different to those on the CD) and one of these should be by Schubert and one of them by Schumann.
4. The successful duo will be notified at the end of the performances on 15th September 2010 and invited to perform in the final round on the evening of September 17th 2010. The duo will be asked to perform a 15 minute recital (one song may be repeated from the previous rounds). One of the songs should be by Schubert and one by Schumann.
5. The prizes for first and second prize will be awarded after final deliberation on 17th September 2010.
